Overview of Trough-Type Cable Trays

Trough-type cable trays, also known as ventilated trough trays, feature a solid or partially ventilated bottom that offers continuous support for cables while allowing some airflow to prevent heat buildup . They are particularly suitable for smaller-diameter control, instrumentation, or communication cables that may sag if installed in ladder-type trays, which have spaced rungs . The ventilated design balances support and ventilation, making it ideal for vertical installations where cable stability is critical.

Vertical Installation Considerations

- **Support and Spacing:** Vertical cable runs require proper support to prevent sagging and maintain the minimum bend radius. Trough trays provide a continuous surface that helps maintain cable alignment and spacing . For long vertical runs, intermediate supports such as wall brackets or center suspensions may be necessary to secure the tray to the structure .
- **Cable Securing:** Use cable ties, clamps, or hold-downs to fix cables within the trough, ensuring they do not shift or pull on connectors. This is especially important for vertical runs where gravity can cause cables to slide or bunch together .
- **Environmental Factors:** Consider the material of the trough tray based on the envi...
