

Vertical Cable Tray Sealing Dimensions and Specifications Table

Vertical cable tray sealing dimensions are determined by tray width, side rail height, cover type, and material thickness, following NEC, NEMA, and IEC standards.

Key Dimensions

1. Width and Depth: The nominal inside width of vertical cable trays typically ranges from 100 mm to 600 mm, depending on cable capacity requirements, while side rail height (depth) controls vertical stacking and sealing effectiveness. Depths are often 50-150 mm for light-duty trays and up to 300 mm for heavy-duty or extra-heavy-duty trays, ensuring proper cable fill and heat dissipation (). 2. Material Thickness: Tray and cover thickness varies by duty rating: light-duty trays may use 1.2-1.5 mm steel, medium-duty 1.5-2.0 mm, and heavy-duty 2.0-3.0 mm. Stainless steel or galvanized finishes are common for corrosion resistance, with duplex coatings providing extended wear life (). 3. Cover and Sealing: Vertical trays often use hinged or removable covers with integral side flanges to maintain a tight seal. Covers are designed to overlap side rails, typically extending 20-30 mm beyond the tray edge, and may include gaskets or rubber seals for environmental protection. Adjustable risers or sliding covers allow alignment with vertical runs and facilitate sealing at joints (). 4. Fittings and Joints: Sealing at vertical joints is achieved using integral flanges, fast-fit clips, or bolted connections. Predetermined fitting locations allow angles in 5° increments, ensuring consistent sealing along vertical risers. Swiftclip or similar fast-fit systems reduce installation time while maintaining a secure seal ()....
