

Vertical trough-type cable tray for fixing cables



Article Overview

Vertical trough-type cable trays are fixed using wall-mounted brackets, trapeze hangers, or specialized tracks, with cables secured via binding tape, hooks, or spiral arrangements depending on size and weight.

Support and Fixing Principles

Material and Structural Requirements: Vertical cable trays are typically made from cold-rolled steel, galvanized steel, or aluminum alloy, with surface treatments like hot-dip galvanizing or electrostatic spraying to ensure corrosion resistance and mechanical strength. The load-bearing capacity should meet at least 200 kg/m, and fire resistance must comply with GB 8624 Class B1 standards . **Support Methods:**

- **Wall-mounted brackets:** Cantilever brackets are fixed directly to walls to support vertical runs.
- **Trapeze hangers:** Suspended from ceilings or structural beams, these provide additional support for long vertical sections .
- **Spacing:** Maintain proper clearances from other services (≥ 300 mm from ducts or pipes) and between multiple tray layers (≥ 150 mm), using isolation plates where necessary .

Cable Fixing Techniques

- **Binding Tape Method:** Cables are threaded with binding tape and secured to the inner wall of the tray. This method is simple but best suited for smaller cables
