

Voltage between wires in the distribution box

In a standard residential distribution box, the voltage between live (phase) wires is typically 220–240V, while the voltage between a live wire and neutral is usually 110–120V in single-phase systems.

Typical Voltage Levels

- Single-phase residential systems: The voltage between a live (phase) wire and neutral is generally 110–120V, and the voltage between the two live wires (phase-to-phase) is 220–240V. This is common in homes in North America and many other regions ().
- Three-phase systems: In commercial or industrial settings, the voltage between any two phase wires can range from 208V to 480V, depending on the system design, while the voltage from phase to neutral is lower, typically 120V or 277V ().

Distribution Box Function

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or panel, divides the main incoming electrical supply into smaller circuits. It contains circuit breakers, fuses, and bus bars that allow safe distribution of electricity to different areas of a building (). The box ensures that each circuit is protected from overloads and short circuits, and it allows isolation of individual circuits for maintenance.
