

What are the grounding requirements for sockets and distribution boxes



Overview

NFPA 70: National Electrical Code Article 250 covers the minimum requirements for grounding and bonding and, although the NEC lists requirements to abide by, it should not be taken as a design manual. The purpose of grounding is the safety of people and property. In addition, four installation rules warrant the continuity of the equipment. If you're working with electrical systems, you know that grounding isn't just some bureaucratic requirement—it's literally the difference between a safe, functional system and a potential disaster. Feeders shall originate in a distribution center. The conductors shall be run as multiconductor cord or cable assemblies or within raceways; or, where not subject to physical damage, they may be run as open conductors on insulators not more than 10 feet.
