

What are the requirements for the installation location of the distribution box

A distribution box should be installed in a dry, well-ventilated, easily accessible location, away from moisture, heat, and corrosive substances, with sufficient space for maintenance and proper height for ergonomic operation.

Key Considerations for Location

Accessibility and Maintenance: The box should be easily reachable by electricians and maintenance personnel to allow safe operation, routine inspections, and emergency fault handling. It should not be placed in high-traffic areas or obstructed spaces . **Environmental Protection:** Avoid areas with high humidity, water exposure, corrosive gases, flammable or explosive substances, and direct sunlight. For outdoor installations, use enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings (e.g., IP66 or NEMA 4) and consider rain covers, cooling fans, or dehumidifiers if necessary . **Height and Ergonomics:** For residential installations, the recommended height is approximately 1.5 meters above the ground. Industrial installations may vary depending on surrounding equipment, but the height should allow comfortable operation and inspection . **Ground-mounted stainless steel enclosures** should have a bottom surface between 1.3 and 1.5 meters from the floor for fixed boxes, and 0.6 to 1.5 meters for mobile units . **Ventilation and Space:** Ensure sufficient clearance around the box for airflow, heat dissipation, and maintenance. Ideally, the space should accommodate at least two people working simultaneously . **Proximity to Power Sources:** The distribut...
