

What are the standards for transporting bulk optical cables



Article Overview

Bulk optical cables must be transported on drums in an upright position, using proper lifting equipment, with adherence to international handling and storage standards to prevent damage.

Handling and Lifting

Optical fiber cable drums should always be handled in an upright position to prevent deformation and cable damage. When lifting drums, a shaft through the drum center and a spreader beam should be used; if a spreader is not available, ropes must not contact the drum flanges to avoid crushing or damaging the cable . Forklifts should have forks longer than the drum width, and the drum should be raised 6–8 inches above the ground during movement. Drums must not be released until the forklift has completely stopped, and sufficient spacing should be maintained between drums to prevent collisions .

Transportation

During transport, drums should remain upright and secured to prevent rolling or tipping. Trucks or trailers must be equipped with supports or restraints to maintain drum stability. Care should be taken to avoid sharp impacts, excessive vibration, or sudden stops, as optical fibers are sensitive to mechanical stress . For long-distance or industrial transport, environmental factors such as temperature, humidity, and chemical exposure should be considered, following the M.I.C.E. (Mechanical, Ingress...
