The Mohammed VI Bridge, Hassan II Bridge, and Oued Cherrat Bridge are among Morocco's most significant bridges.

Mohammed VI Bridge

The Mohammed VI Bridge is a cable-stayed bridge near Rabat, spanning the Bouregreg River. At 950 meters in length with two arched towers 200 meters high, it was the longest cable-stayed bridge in Africa until 2025. It connects the cities of Rabat and Salé and is part of the Rabat Grand Bypass motorway, handling an estimated 50,000 vehicles daily. The bridge was inaugurated on July 7, 2016, and features a modern LED lighting system capable of displaying 16 million colors .

Hassan II Bridge

The Hassan II Bridge is another important Moroccan bridge, known for its engineering and strategic location. It serves as a key crossing over major rivers and contributes to Morocco's national road network, facilitating transport and commerce. While less detailed in the sources, it is recognized as a landmark structure in the country .

Oued Cherrat Bridge

The Oued Cherrat Bridge is a suspension bridge notable for its design and historical significance. It is part of Morocco's extensive network of over 5,300 bridges, supporting regional connectivity and rural accessibility.
