Core Function

The primary function of an optical amplifier is to increase the intensity of an incoming light signal while preserving its original information, such as phase, frequency, and polarization, without the need for electrical conversion. This allows optical signals to travel longer distances through fiber-optic cables without significant attenuation or distortion, which is essential for high-speed telecommunications and data networks.

How It Works

Optical amplification is typically achieved through stimulated emission in a gain medium. The gain medium contains atoms, ions, or molecules in an excited state, which, when stimulated by incoming photons, emit additional photons coherent with the original signal. The energy for this process is supplied externally, either optically (using a pump laser) or electrically, depending on the amplifier type.

Types of Optical Amplifiers

- Erbium-Doped Fiber Amplifiers (EDFA): Use optical fibers doped with erbium ions. Pump lasers excite the ions, and the passing signal stimulates photon emission, amplifying the light.
