Adapters interface different types of fiber connectors, ensuring seamless connectivity between cables . 4. Cable Clamps and Brackets Internal support structures, including brackets and clamps, secure the optical cables and reinforce the mechanical strength of the junction box. They prevent lateral stress from affecting the fibers and maintain proper alignment . 5. Protective Plates and Heat-Shrink Jackets Protective plates shield the splices and connectors, while heat-shrink jackets cover the fiber cores to ensure the integrity of connections and prevent damage from environmental factors . 6. Sealing Components Seals, gaskets, or gel-based materials are used to prevent water ingre...
