LC multimode fiber is a type of fiber optic cable that uses a multimode fiber core with LC connectors on both ends, designed for short-distance, high-speed data transmission.

Overview

Multimode fiber is an optical fiber with a relatively large core diameter, typically 50 or 62.5 micrometers, which allows multiple light modes to propagate simultaneously. This design makes it ideal for short-distance communication, such as within buildings, data centers, or campus networks, because modal dispersion limits the maximum transmission distance but supports high data rates up to 800 Gbit/s . Multimode fiber is generally less expensive than single-mode fiber and is widely used for backbone and high-density applications . LC connectors (Lucent Connectors) are small form-factor connectors that provide low insertion loss and high return loss, making them suitable for high-density patching in telecom rooms and data centers . An LC multimode fiber patch cord has LC connectors on both ends, allowing quick and reliable connections between switches, patch panels, optical transceivers, and other network devices .

Structure of LC Multimode Fiber Patch Cord

- Core: Transmits optical signals; in multimode fiber, the core is larger to support multiple light paths .
- Cladding: Surrounds the core and confines light via total internal reflection .
- Buffer Coating: Protects the fiber from physical damage .
- Outer Jacket: Provides durability and environmental protection
