

What is the connector of an optical fiber cable called

The connector for an optical fiber cable is called a fiber optic connector or optical fiber connector.

A fiber optic connector is a mechanical device designed to join optical fibers, allowing light signals to pass through with minimal loss while enabling easy connection and disconnection, unlike permanent splicing methods (fiber splicing) which are fixed . These connectors are widely used in telecommunications, data centers, and industrial networks where flexibility and maintenance are important .

Structure and Function

Fiber optic connectors typically include several key components:

- Ferrule: A cylindrical piece that holds and aligns the fiber precisely.
- Connector body: The protective housing that secures the ferrule and provides durability.
- Attachment mechanism: Push-pull, latch, or threaded systems that ensure a secure connection.
- Boots: Protective covers that prevent bending or damage to the fiber near the connector . Most connectors are spring-loaded, pressing the fiber faces together to maintain optimal alignment and minimize signal loss or reflection .
