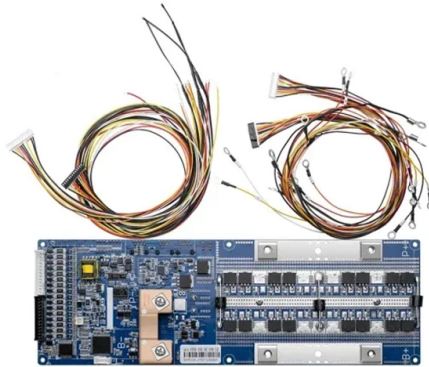


What is the fiber optic splice tray called
