A round fiber optic patch cord is a flexible fiber cable with connectors on both ends, designed to transmit optical signals between devices in a network.

Definition and Function

A fiber optic patch cord—also called a fiber jumper—is a short, pre-terminated fiber cable used to connect two optical devices, such as switches, servers, or patch panels, allowing light signals to pass between them. The "round" designation refers to the circular cross-section of the cable jacket, which provides flexibility and ease of handling, especially in indoor or high-density environments.

Structure

A typical round fiber optic patch cord consists of:

- Optical fiber core and cladding: The glass core carries the light signal, while the cladding reflects light back into the core to maintain signal integrity.
- Buffer coating: Protects the fiber from mechanical stress.
- Strength members: Often aramid yarn (Kevlar) is included under the jacket to enhance durability and prevent breakage.
- Outer jacket: The round jacket provides physical protection and flexibility. Common diameters are 2.0 mm and 3.0 mm, with thinner cables suited for high-density racks and thicker cables offering better mechanical strength
