

What lightning protection equipment should be installed in the distribution box

Yes, installing lightning protection on a distribution box is necessary to safeguard electrical systems and connected equipment from lightning-induced surges and transient overvoltages.

Importance of Lightning Protection

Lightning strikes can generate extremely high voltages and currents in a very short time, which can damage electrical equipment, cause fires, or disrupt operations. A surge protective device (SPD) installed in the distribution box acts as the first line of defense, diverting excess energy safely to the ground and protecting downstream devices . This is especially critical for buildings with external lightning protection or overhead power lines, as the risk of surges is higher .

Types of Surge Protection Devices

- Type I SPD: Installed at the main incoming line (service entrance) to handle the highest energy from lightning or utility surges. It is essential for buildings with external lightning protection .
- Type II SPD: Installed in sub-distribution boards to limit residual voltage to safe levels for downstream circuits. It is used when the building has no external lightning protection or for additional protection after Type I devices .
- Type III SPD: Installed close to sensitive equipment, such as IT devices or control panels, to provide final-stage protection against residual surges
