

What materials are used for fiber optic cable ducts

High-density polyethylene (HDPE) is generally the preferred material for fiber optic cable ducts due to its durability, flexibility, and resistance to environmental stresses.

HDPE (High-Density Polyethylene)

HDPE is widely used for both underground and aerial fiber optic installations. It offers excellent flexibility, allowing it to navigate bends and curves in duct systems without cracking. HDPE is resistant to UV exposure, temperature extremes, petroleum compounds, and salt, making it suitable for diverse environments. It is compatible with directional boring, plowing, open trenching, and direct burial, which makes installation easier and more versatile. Its low friction coefficient also facilitates longer cable blowing distances and reduces installation stress on fibers .

PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride)

PVC ducts are cost-effective and provide good corrosion resistance. They are stiffer than HDPE, which helps maintain straight runs in open trenches. However, PVC can become brittle in cold temperatures and is less suitable for trenchless installations that require bending. PVC is often used in duct banks encased in concrete or in urban areas where rigidity is advantageous .
