Regular visual inspections and cleaning are critical. Dust, oil, and microscopic debris on connectors can cause signal degradation, increased insertion loss, and reflectance issues. Using a fiber inspection microscope and approved cleaning tools ensures connectors are free from contaminants before connections or testing. Protective covers should be used immediately after cleaning to prevent re-contamination .
