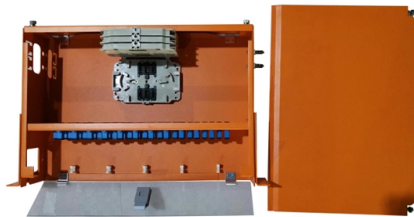


What tools are used to repair fiber optic cables

- **Precision Cleavers:** Produce a clean, flat fiber end face, critical for low-loss fusion or mechanical splicing. Aim for less than a 1-degree angle on cleaves for optimal performance .
- **Kevlar Scissors:** Specially designed to cut the Kevlar yarn inside fiber cables safely .
