A KG fiber optic cable is a type of optical fiber cable designed to transmit data as light signals, typically used for high-speed, long-distance, or high-bandwidth applications.

Overview

Fiber optic cables, including KG cables, use light to transmit information through ultra-thin strands of glass or plastic called optical fibers, rather than electrical signals used in copper cables, which makes them immune to electromagnetic interference and capable of much higher data rates and longer transmission distances . Each fiber consists of a core that carries the light signal, surrounded by cladding to reflect light back into the core, and protective layers to ensure durability in various environments .

Types of Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables generally fall into two main categories:

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Features a very thin core (8-9 μm) that carries a single light signal, ideal for long-distance transmission with minimal signal loss .
- Multimode fiber (MMF): Has a larger core (50-62.5 μm) that can carry multiple light signals simultaneously, suitable for shorter distances and high-speed data within buildings or campuses . KG fiber optic cables are likely classified under one of these...
