The insulation type must match the installation environment: for example, cables in damp areas or outdoors should meet at least IP44 protection standards . The cable should also have sufficient heat resistance to handle the expected load without degradation . 3. Consider Installation Conditions Cables must be installed according to proper bending radius and pulling tension to avoid damage. Grouping multiple cables together or running them in conduits may require derating factors to prevent overheating. The installation method, ambient temperature, and proximity to other heat sources all affect the cable's ampacity . 4. Ensure Compliance with Standards Cables and terminals must comply with national and international electrical safety standards, such as IEC 60364-5-52 for ampacity and voltage drop c...
