- PDLC (Pushable Durable LC): Also called “Mini SC” outdoor connectors, PDLC uses a standard LC duplex interface inside a rugged, waterproof shell. It is widely used in FTTA (Fiber to the Antenna) and outdoor base station deployments, providing stable, dustproof, and waterproof connections .
- IDC (Insulation Displacement Connector): Features a metal screw-thread connection with male and female types, eliminating the need for adapters. It is suitable for 2-core, 4-core, or multi-core outdoor applications, including sensing, electric power, and FTTA .
- NSN (Nokia Siemens Networks) Connector: Designed for telecom outdoor environments, NSN connectors have a corrugated waterproof rubber boot with an L...
