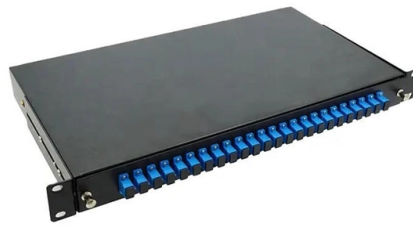


What type of switch is used for fiber optic monitoring

They offer durability, fast switching, and low maintenance, which is advantageous for continuous monitoring in mission-critical systems . **Thermo-Optic and Acousto-Optic Switches:** Thermo-optic switches adjust the refractive index via temperature changes, while acousto-optic switches use sound waves to control light diffraction. Both types are used in specialized monitoring applications requiring wavelength selection or tunable signal routing .
