

When cable trays are installed horizontally



Article Overview

Horizontal cable trays must be installed level, properly supported, and with cables securely fixed to ensure safety, load management, and compliance with standards.

Key Installation Guidelines

Support and Mounting: Horizontal cable trays should be supported at regular intervals to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Typical support spacing ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load, with a maximum load per hanger generally between 318 kg and 340 kg for ladder trays. Supports should be positioned carefully, and direct plate connections should not be placed at the midpoint of the span or directly on support points.

Alignment and Leveling: Trays must be installed straight and level. Proper alignment ensures that cables can be laid without stress and that the tray system remains stable over time. Horizontal adjustment is limited by the length of vertical hangers, so precise positioning is essential.

Cable Fixing: Cables within horizontal trays should be secured using nylon straps, binding wires, or metal clips. Fixing points are recommended at both ends of the cable, at bends, and at cable joints to prevent movement and maintain organization.

Environmental Considerations: When trays are installed near pipelines, corrosive substances, or thermal sources, maintain minimum distances (e.g., 500 mm from insulated thermal pipelines, 1000 mm from uninsulated pipelines) and use protective covers or insulation boards as needed. Outdoor trays should have protective covers to shield cables from weather and mechanical damage.
