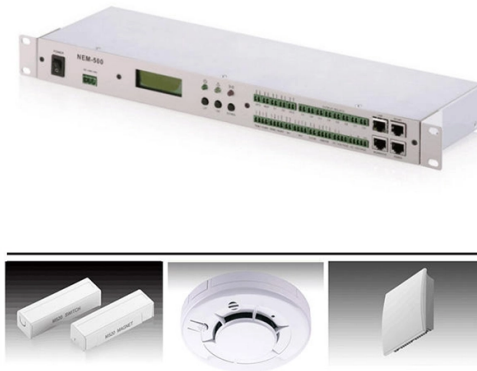


Where are secondary distribution boxes used

Secondary distribution boxes are typically located near the point of use, such as inside buildings, in basements, utility rooms, garages, or mounted outdoors close to the electrical meter, depending on the system design and accessibility requirements.

General Placement in Electrical Systems

Secondary distribution boxes, also called distribution panels or boards, receive low-voltage power from distribution transformers and route it to individual circuits for end users. In urban and suburban areas, these boxes are often positioned close to the transformer or service entry point to minimize voltage drop and ensure efficient distribution. In larger buildings, multiple secondary panels may be installed throughout the structure to serve different floors or sections, often connected via busbars or cable runs.

Residential Locations

In homes, secondary distribution boxes are commonly found in basements, garages, utility rooms, or mounted outside near the electrical meter. They are usually rectangular metal boxes containing circuit breakers or fuses, and must have at least 3 feet of clearance in front for safety and maintenance access. The main breaker is typically located at the top or bottom of the panel, controlling power to the entire home
