

Where to connect the wiring when the power is off after replacing the distribution box



Overview

With the electricity still off at the meter, carefully re-connect the 2 main wires that come from the meter to the panel. These will each feed a “hot bus bar” with each of them being 120v. Remove the breaker and convert panel to main lug and connect directly (as the old one is now). And backfeed the panel through 100A breaker. To save time and avoid being without power for an extended period, you can install the new panel on the wall next to the old one and then proceed with the preliminary wiring of the new and some of the existing circuits into the new panel (steps 4. Because mistakes can result in electrical shock, fire hazards, or code violations, this task must comply with. Connection method: Each switch takes a wire from the incoming point and connects it to the incoming end of the switch, or uses parallel connection to reduce the difficulty of wiring.
