

Which port should I connect to on the gigabit switch

For standard gigabit switch access, use the RJ45 Ethernet ports with Cat5e or higher cabling; SFP ports are typically reserved for uplinks or long-distance fiber connections.

RJ45 Ports for Access

RJ45 ports are the most common choice for connecting end devices such as computers, printers, or access layer switches to a gigabit switch. They support 100/1000BASE-T Ethernet and use standard twisted-pair cables like Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6a, which can reliably carry gigabit speeds up to 100 meters . These ports are cost-effective, easy to deploy, and ideal for most office, campus, or branch network environments .

SFP Ports for Uplinks and Fiber

SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) ports are modular and can accept either fiber or copper transceivers. They are primarily used for uplinks to aggregation or core switches or for connecting devices over longer distances than copper allows . While SFP ports can support 1 Gbps with the appropriate module, they are generally not necessary for standard desktop or access connections unless you need fiber connectivity or extended reach beyond 100 meters .
