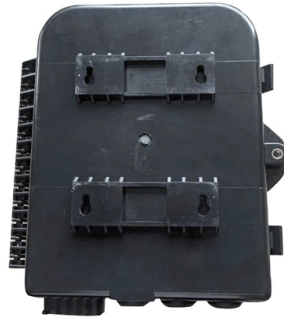


Which type of jumper should be used between the OLT and the core switch



Article Overview

Use a single-mode LC-LC duplex fiber optic jumper to connect the OLT to the core switch.

Connector Type

For most modern OLTs and core switches, the SFP or SFP+ transceivers are used, which typically require LC connectors. LC connectors are small, high-density, and easy to operate, making them ideal for data center and telecom environments . Avoid SC or ST connectors unless your equipment specifically uses GBIC modules or older interfaces .

Fiber Mode

- Single-mode fiber (OS2) is recommended for OLT-to-core switch connections because these links are usually long-distance or backbone connections within the network .
- Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) is generally used for short-distance connections inside data centers, but single-mode ensures minimal signal loss over longer distances .

Duplex vs Simplex

- Duplex jumpers are required because Ethernet and GPON links use separate fibers for transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx)
