Common Causes

1. Router Limitations Older or low-end routers may not support the high speeds provided by fiber connections. Routers with outdated Wi-Fi standards (e.g., Wi-Fi 4 or Wi-Fi 5) or limited processing power can bottleneck your connection, especially if multiple devices are connected simultaneously . 2. Router Placement and Signal Interference Physical obstructions like walls, furniture, or electronic devices can weaken Wi-Fi signals. Additionally, interference from neighboring networks or multiple Wi-Fi networks in the same home can reduce effective speeds . 3. Ethernet Cable Quality If you are using wired connections, older Ethernet cables (Cat 5 or lower) may not support gigabit speeds. For optimal fiber performance, use Cat 6 or higher cables . 4. Network Congestion High traffic on your home network, such as multiple devices streaming, gaming, or downloading large files simultaneously, can overload the router and reduce speeds . 5. Faulty or Loose Connections Damaged or improperly connected fiber or Ethernet cables can cause signal loss and slow performance. Even minor bends or dirt on fiber connectors can degrade signal quality . 6. Device Limitations Older computers, smartphones, or tablets may have network interface cards (NICs) that cannot handle gigabit speeds, limiting the speed experienced on those devices
