

Wiring method for power distribution box module sockets



Article Overview

Proper wiring of a power distribution box module socket involves connecting the incoming phase, neutral, and earth to the main protective devices, then distributing power to output circuits while ensuring grounding and safety interlocks.

Key Components and Connections

- Main Input Connection
 - The incoming supply (phase and neutral) is connected to the main MCB or main switch. For single-phase domestic systems, a double-pole MCB is typically used as the main switch, rated around 63A for standard installations .
 - In high-current modular systems, the Earth connection is made first and disconnected last (FMLB principle) to ensure safety .
- Protective Devices
 - RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Protects against leakage currents and electric shock. The RCCB input is connected to the output of the main MCB, and its output feeds the branch MCBs .
 - Branch MCBs: Single-pole MCBs are used for individual loads, while double-pole MCBs may be used for special or high-power loads .
- Neutral and Earth Distribution
 - A neutral link distributes the neutral supply to all output circuits. Each load's neutral wire connects to this link.
 - The earth link connects the incoming supply earth and all load earths, ensuring pr...
