Cabinet Layout and Component Placement

Electrical cabinets, including PLC control panels, house components such as PLCs, power supplies, I/O modules, relays, and motor starters. Components should be arranged to allow easy access, proper ventilation, and clear wiring paths. High-voltage and low-voltage circuits must be physically separated, and sensitive electronics should be shielded from power lines to prevent interference . Adequate spacing between devices ensures safe operation and simplifies maintenance .

Wiring Practices

- **Organized Wiring:** Use cable ties, ducts, and trays to keep wires neat and prevent tangling. Logical routing reduces errors and improves troubleshooting .
- **Terminal Connections:** Use bootlace ferrules for bare-end wires to ensure secure connections in terminal blocks and prevent strand damage .
- **Segregation:** Separate power and control cables to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain signal integrity .
- **Voltage Considerations:** Control cabinets often handle multiple voltages, e.g., 220/440V AC for motors and 24V DC for control circuits. Step-down transformers or power supplies are used to provide appropriate voltages to PLCs and I/O modules .
